

HOUSE No. 1382

By Mr. O'Leary of Boston, petition of Gerald F. O'Leary that the Massachusetts Port Authority be authorized to formulate a master development program for commercial shipping facilities in and around Boston Harbor. State Administration.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Eight.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MASSACHUSETTS PORT AUTHORITY TO FORMULATE A MASTER DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM FOR COMMERCIAL SHIPPING FACILITIES IN AND AROUND BOSTON HARBOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 465 of the acts of 1956 is hereby amended
2 by adding after section 21 thereof, the following new section:—

3 *Section 21A.* On or before the thirtieth day of November,
4 nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, the Authority shall present
5 a master development plan for Boston harbor to the governor
6 and to the general court. Such plan shall include a program
7 showing contemplated construction, acquisition, costs, revenue
8 funding and use of commercial shipping activities and related
9 properties in and around Boston harbor for the ensuing ten year
10 period.

11 Such plan and program shall be reviewed and updated an-
12 nually by the Authority and such review and a report on the
13 progress made on such plan and program shall be included in
14 the annual report required under section twenty-one hereof.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

It is the duty of the State to provide for the education of its children, and to see that the same is done in a manner that will best promote the interests of the State.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE EDUCATION OF THE CHILDREN OF THE COMMONWEALTH, AND TO AMEND AN ACT PASSED IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty.

- 1 Section 1. Chapter 80B of the Acts of 1919 is hereby amended so that the following shall be substituted therefor:
- 2 The board of education shall have the following powers and duties:
- 3 (a) to determine the number of schools to be established in the Commonwealth;
- 4 (b) to determine the location of the schools;
- 5 (c) to determine the number of pupils to be received in each school;
- 6 (d) to determine the amount of the State aid to be paid to each school;
- 7 (e) to determine the amount of the State aid to be paid to each district;
- 8 (f) to determine the amount of the State aid to be paid to each town;
- 9 (g) to determine the amount of the State aid to be paid to each city;
- 10 (h) to determine the amount of the State aid to be paid to each county;
- 11 (i) to determine the amount of the State aid to be paid to each parish;
- 12 (j) to determine the amount of the State aid to be paid to each territory;
- 13 (k) to determine the amount of the State aid to be paid to each Indian reservation;
- 14 (l) to determine the amount of the State aid to be paid to each other institution;
- 15 (m) to determine the amount of the State aid to be paid to each other institution;
- 16 (n) to determine the amount of the State aid to be paid to each other institution;
- 17 (o) to determine the amount of the State aid to be paid to each other institution;
- 18 (p) to determine the amount of the State aid to be paid to each other institution;
- 19 (q) to determine the amount of the State aid to be paid to each other institution;
- 20 (r) to determine the amount of the State aid to be paid to each other institution;
- 21 (s) to determine the amount of the State aid to be paid to each other institution.

Section 2. The word "shall" shall be construed to mean "may" unless otherwise provided.
