AN ACT RESTRICTING THE DISPOSITION OF CERTAIN TERMINAL FACILITIES AT NORTH STATION IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority shall
2 neither cause nor permit any facility under its control,
3 through ownership, contract or other means, as of December
4 first, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven, in the North Station
5 area in the city of Boston to be sold, transferred, reduced,
6 diminished or demolished.
