AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SCHOOL OF VETERINARY MEDICINE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 75 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 36, under the caption "School of
- 3 Veterinary Medicine," the following section:—
- 4 Section 37. The trustees shall establish and maintain at
- 5 Amherst a graduate school for instruction in veterinary
- 6 medicine subjects. The course of instruction shall be for four
- 7 years.
