AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A SALARY DIFFERENTIAL FOR POLICE OFFICERS WHO ARE REQUIRED TO WORK AT NIGHT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting the following new section:—
3 *Section 108M.* Notwithstanding the provisions of any
4 general or special law to the contrary, regular police officers
5 of every city or town required to render services between the
6 hours of six postmeridian and six antemeridian shall be
7 compensated by a salary increase equal to ten per cent of the
8 hourly rate of their regular compensation; provided, how-
9 ever, that such increase shall not become a permanent part of
10 the salary of said police officers and shall only be paid for
11 those hours actually worked between the hours of six post-
12 meridian and six antemeridian. The compensation paid to
13 any police officer shall not be reduced by reason of the
14 acceptance of this section.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect in any city or town
2 which accepts this act.
