By Mr. Frye of Boston, petition of Gladys Shapiro and Maurice E. Frye, Jr., that persons operating restaurants, hotels and certain other establishments where food and beverages are served be required to provide toilet facilities for their patrons. Social Welfare.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE TOILET FACILITIES FOR THE PUBLIC IN CERTAIN ESTABLISHMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Every person conducting a restaurant, cafe, tavern, hotel
2 or establishment where food and beverages are served, and
3 upon whose premises seventy-five or more persons may be
4 served, and any person conducting a retail store or establish-
5 ment which has a selling area of one thousand or more square
6 feet, shall be required to provide public toilet facilities which
7 shall consist of a minimum of one toilet for women and one
8 toilet for men. Whoever violates this section shall be pun-
9 ished by a fine of not more than twenty-five dollars.
