AN ACT DIRECTING THE COMMONWEALTH TO ASSUME CERTAIN COSTS OF PROJECTS IN WHICH IT IS INVOLVED AT TIME OF INCURRING SAID COSTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special
2 law to the contrary, the commonwealth is hereby directed to
3 assume its full obligation of all projects in which it is
4 participating with cities and towns of the commonwealth at
5 the time of incurring of said costs. The commonwealth shall
6 pay its total share to the respective cities and towns at the
7 time that said indebtedness is incurred.
