AN ACT VALIDATING THE APPOINTMENT OF DOCTOR RAYMOND E. LORD AS SCHOOL DENTIST IN THE SERVICE OF THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF NORTH ADAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Doctor Raymond E. Lord, veteran, shall be deemed to have
2 been appointed as a permanent part-time school dentist in the
3 health department of the city of North Adams, under the pro-
4 visions of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws, effective
5 September fourth, nineteen hundred and sixty-four, notwith-
6 standing the failure of the division of civil service to certify
7 his name for consideration in appointment after having passed
8 the open competitive examination for school dentist on Feb-
9 bruary eighth, nineteen hundred and sixty-four and having
10 been in a position on the list to be certified for permanent
11 appointment.
