AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PERMISSIBLE DIMENSIONS OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND OTHER VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 19 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the fifth sentence and inserting in
3 place thereof the following sentence:—No motor vehicle, trailer
4 or other vehicle, carrying a crane or boom whether or not
5 permanently or temporarily attached to said vehicle or trailer,
6 if such crane or boom extends more than four feet beyond the
7 bed or body of the vehicle or trailer shall be operated or drawn
8 on any way unless vehicles approaching from the rear are pro-
9 tected from the rear projecting crane or boom by another ve-
10 hicle following immediately behind such projecting extremity.
