## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Eight.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE REGISTRAR OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ESTABLISH RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE USE OF CERTAIN LIGHTS ON MOTOR VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 7 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, is hereby  
2 amended by adding at the end of the fourteenth sentence the  
3 following new sentence:—He may also make rules and regu-  
4 lations governing, or prohibiting altogether, the use or for-  
5 ward display of such other lights on motor vehicles as he may  
6 deem necessary for public safety.
