AN ACT INCREASING THE LIMITS OF LIABILITIES OF OWNERS OF MOTOR VEHICLES FOR THE REASONABLE COST OF REMOVAL AND STORAGE UNDER SECTION TWENTY-TWO D OF CHAPTER FORTY OF THE GENERAL LAWS.

1 *Whereas*, the deferred operation of this act would prevent
2 the proper regulation of traffic in the various cities and towns.
3 Therefore, this act is hereby declared to be an emergency law
4 necessary for the preservation of the public safety and con-
5 venience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 22D of chapter 40 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by substituting in the fourth sentence thereof for the
3 word "eight" the word: — twelve — for the words "one dollar
4 and fifty cents" the words: — two dollars, — and for the words
5 "one dollar" the words: — one dollar and fifty cents.
