*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

- 4 "arithmetic," the words:—modern economics.

SECTION 1. In relation to the registration of voters in the several counties of the Commonwealth, the following provisions shall be observed: -
