AN ACT TO ESTABLISH AUTHORITY TO EXERCISE THE POWER OF EMINENT DOMAIN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 29 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 27, the following new section:—
- 3 *Section 27A* any special act, including Capital Outlay
- 4 Programs, providing funds for the acquisition of land by
- 5 purchase or eminent domain shall confer authority to exercise
- 6 the power of eminent domain upon the agency to whom such
- 7 funds are allocated.
