

HOUSE No. 1841

By Mr. Bevilacqua of Haverhill, petition of Fred C. Basile that the office of tree warden and insect pest control superintendent be held jointly by one person in cities and towns. Local Affairs.

AN ACT TO HAVE THE OFFICE OF TREE WARDEN AND INSECT PEST CONTROL SUPERINTENDENT TO BE HELD JOINTLY BY ONE PERSON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 87 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting at the end thereof the following sen-
3 tences:—The powers of the tree warden be extended to
4 include all public shade trees within the city or town
5 boundaries; including state or county roads, parks, and
6 district commissions. In towns persons running for elective
7 office would run as both tree warden and insect pest control
8 superintendent in one position. In cities where appointments
9 are made the positions would be joined as one.
