## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Eight.

AN ACT EXEMPTING NON-RESIDENT MILITARY PERSONNEL FROM THE PROVISIONS OF LAW IMPOSING LICENSE FEES ON TRAILER COACH PARKS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 140 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting the following sentence at the end of section  
3 32G:—No additional license fee imposed by this section shall  
4 be collected from the owner of such a trailer coach park on  
5 land or space occupied in any trailer coach parks by mobile  
6 homes owned solely by non-resident military personnel  
7 absent from their home states by reason of compliance with  
8 military or naval orders.
