AN ACT GRANTING CREDITABLE SERVICE TO CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM WHO SERVED IN THE ARMED FORCES DURING CERTAIN PERIODS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subdivision (1) of section 5 of chapter 32 of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by inserting after paragraph (g) the
3 following paragraph:—
4 (h) Any member who was appointed while serving in the
5 armed forces between January first, nineteen hundred and
6 forty and July first, nineteen hundred and fifty-five, or who,
7 during such period, was certified for appointment, but entered
8 the military service before such appointment and was sub-
9 sequently appointed from the same list after his discharge or
10 release from military service, shall have credited as creditable
11 service towards retirement the period beginning as of the date
12 of such appointment or certification and ending as of the date
13 of his discharge or release from military service.
