AN ACT PERMITTING TENANT REPRESENTATION ON HOUSING AUTHORITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 26L of chapter 121 of the General Laws as most
2 recently amended by chapter 128 of the acts of 1955 is hereby
3 further amended by striking out the fourth sentence and in-
4 serting in place thereof the following:—Any tenant in a
5 project operated by a housing authority shall be eligible for
6 election or appointment to such housing authority.
