RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION OF CERTAIN PRIVATE SCHOOLS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS CONCERNING THEIR OPERATION.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of education is hereby au-
2 thorized and directed to make an investigation of non-degree
3 granting educational institutions, including private colleges,
4 junior colleges, trade, business, and professional schools with-
5 in the commonwealth with a view to promulgate standards for
6 the administration, operation, and licensing thereof and estab-
7 lishing regulations over the nature and type of advertising
8 material and other media utilized by such institutions in the
9 solicitation of students, with emphasis upon the representa-
10 tions made by such schools. Said department shall report to
11 the general court the results of its investigation, and its rec-
12 ommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation neces-
13 sary to carry said recommendations into effect, by filing the
14 same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or
15 before the first Wednesday of December, nineteen hundred
16 and sixty-eight.
