AN ACT AUTHORIZING RETIRED OFFICERS OF THE DIVISION OF STATE POLICE TO BE PAID COMPENSATION FOR CERTAIN SERVICES RENDERED TO THE COMMONWEALTH OR ITS POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 91 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding at the end thereof the following:—
- 3 This section shall not apply to any person who has served
- 4 for twenty years or more in the uniformed branch of the
- 5 division of state police and who was forced to retire from the
- 6 division because of having attained a prescribed age.
