1 *Resolved*, That a special commission to consist of one
2 member of the senate, three members of the house of repre-
3 sentatives, and five persons to be appointed by the governor,
4 is hereby established for the purpose of making an investiga-
5 tion and study relative to the advisability of authorizing the
6 creation of regional housing authorities, and to consider the
7 nature and scope, and such other matters relative thereto as
8 the commission deems reasonable and proper.
