AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE FINANCING OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS MEDICAL SCHOOL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 276 of the acts of 1967 is hereby
2 amended by striking out section 2 and inserting in place
3 thereof the following section:—

8067-98 For the acquisition of certain land in the city of Worcester for a site for the medical school, or land with buildings thereon, by purchase or by eminent domain under chapter seventy-nine of the General Laws; provided, that no payment shall be made for the purchase of said property until an independent appraisal of the value of the property has been made by a qualified, disinterested appraiser; for the preparation of a master plan and the necessary engineering for the development of the site; for the preparation of plans for medical science facilities, a teaching hospital and housing facilities; for the development of the site and for the construction of medical science facilities, including the cost of furnishings and equipment and necessary utility services; and provided, further, that any sums which may be made available for the purposes of this act shall be deposited in the Federal Capital Improvement Fund and shall be expended without further appropriation to meet a portion of the cost of the total authorized in chapter eight hundred and forty-seven of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-five and the sum authorized by this item; to be in addition to the amount appropriated in item 8066-98 of section two of said chapter eight hundred and forty-seven

1 SECTION 2. Section 7 of said chapter 276 is hereby amended
2 by striking out, in lines 8 and 9, the words "twenty-two
3 million, five hundred thousand" and inserting in place thereof
4 the words:—forty-five million.
