## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Eight.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO PRESERVATION OF CIVIL SERVICE APPLICATIONS, RECOMMENDATIONS AND EXAMINATION PAPERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 31 of the General Laws is hereby amended by strik-  
2 ing section 29, as most recently amended by chapter 459 of  
3 the acts of 1967, and inserting in place thereof the following  
4 section:—

5 *Section 29.* Records of the proceedings of the commission  
6 and of the director, all recommendations of applicants and all  
7 applications and examination papers, shall be kept on file and  
8 shall be open to public inspection under the rules of the com-  
9 mission. Each application, recommendation and examination  
10 paper shall be preserved for a period of at least two years,  
11 but may be destroyed thereafter.
