AN ACT TO PROMOTE RECRUITMENT IN POVERTY AREAS BY THE MASSACHUSETTS NATIONAL GUARD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

- 1 Section 12 of chapter 33 of the General Laws, as amended
- 2 by chapter 590 of the acts of 1954, is hereby further amended
- 3 by adding at the end thereof the following:—
- 4 The commander-in-chief may, by temporary regulation,
- 5 recruit and expand the national guard above its authorized
- 6 level in the case of inhabitants of low-income areas who are
- 7 at or above the legal age for leaving school. Such recruits shall
- 8 ordinarily be assigned, after basic training and training in riot
- 9 control, to specialties which are in labor-short areas useful to
- 10 the national guard.
