AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ALLOCATION OR REALLOCATION IN THE GENERAL SALARY SCHEDULE OF THE CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINER POSITIONS AND THE PERSONNEL ANALYST POSITIONS TO CORRECT CERTAIN INEQUITIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 To implement the principle of fair and equal pay for  
2 similar work as set forth in paragraph 4 of section forty-five  
3 of chapter thirty of the General Laws, the director of  
4 personnel and standardization, notwithstanding the provi-  
5 sions of any law or rule to the contrary, shall allocate or  
6 reallocate to job groups in the general salary schedule  
7 included in section forty-six of said chapter thirty the  
8 several examiner positions in the division of civil service and  
9 the several analyst positions in the bureau of personnel as  
10 follows: junior civil service examiner in the division of civil  
11 service to the same job group as personnel analyst in the  
12 bureau of personnel, senior civil service examiner in the  
13 division of civil service to the same job group as senior  
14 personnel analyst in the bureau of personnel, supervising civil  
15 service examiner in the division of civil service to the same  
16 job group as supervising personnel analyst in the bureau of  
17 personnel, and principal civil service examiner in the divi-  
18 sion of civil service to the job group in said salary schedule  
19 which is one job group lower than the job group to which  
20 supervising civil service examiner and supervising personnel  
21 analyst are allocated or reallocated.
