## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Eight.

### AN ACT PROHIBITING THE SALE OF MERCHANDISE AT CEMETERIES BY CERTAIN PERSONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 114 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 430 the following section:—
- 3 *Section 43P.* No cemetery or crematory corporation, and no
- 4 person in charge or control of any cemetery, shall sell any
- 5 merchandise, except grave plots and gravestones, within the
- 6 confines of a cemetery. Whoever violates the provisions of
- 7 this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than five
- 8 hundred dollars.
