## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Eight.

### AN ACT INCREASING THE COMPENSATION OF JURORS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 25 of chapter 262 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the first sentence, as most recently  
3 amended by chapter 678 of the acts of 1967, and inserting in  
4 place thereof the following sentence:— The compensation of  
5 traverse jurors and grand jurors shall be twenty dollars for  
6 each day's service; provided, however, that jurors held under  
7 restraint by order of the court shall receive twenty-five dollars  
8 for each day's service while under restraint.
