AN ACT RELATIVE TO RETIREMENT RIGHTS OF OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF STATE COLLEGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The last paragraph of section 16 of chapter 73 of the
2 General Laws, as appearing in section 15 of chapter 642 of
3 the acts of 1963, is hereby amended by striking out the
4 second sentence and inserting in place thereof the following
5 sentence:—They shall have the same privileges and benefits
6 of other employees of the commonwealth, such as retirement
7 benefits, retirement rights at age seventy, group insurance,
8 industrial accident coverage, and other coverage enjoyed by
9 all employees of the commonwealth.
