AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF CERTAIN ADVISORY COUNCILS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11 of chapter 19 of the General Laws,
2 inserted by section 1 of chapter 735 of the acts of 1966, is
3 hereby amended by striking out the fourth sentence and
4 inserting in place thereof the following sentence:—The
5 chairman shall be elected by and from the council.

1 SECTION 2. Section 12 of said chapter 19, as inserted by
2 section 1 of chapter 735 of the acts of 1966, is hereby
3 amended by striking out the fourth sentence and inserting in
4 place thereof the following sentence:—The chairman shall be
5 elected by and from the council.
