RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE UNWARRANTED DELAY IN PAYING COMPENSATION UNDER THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT IN CERTAIN CASES.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two mem-  
2 bers of the senate, three members of the house of representa-  
3 tives, the chairman of the industrial accident board or his des-  
4 ignee, the commissioner of insurance or his designee, and two  
5 persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby established  
6 for the purpose of making an investigation and study relative  
7 to the unwarranted delay in paying compensation under the  
8 workmen's compensation act in certain cases, with a view  
9 toward a speedier and more efficient administration of the  
10 workmen's compensation laws.
