## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Eight.

### AN ACT REQUIRING THE PRINTING OF THE HEIGHT OF MOTOR VEHICLES THEREON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 19 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing  
2 in chapter 573 of the acts of 1951, is hereby amended by  
3 inserting after the first paragraph the following paragraph:—  
4 Any motor vehicle registered under the provisions of this  
5 chapter which has a total height exceeding ten feet, excluding  
6 the height of any load thereon, shall have printed in a  
7 conspicuous place upon the side or front of such vehicle such  
8 total height. The letters and numerals required to be printed  
9 upon such vehicle shall have a height of at least four  
10 inches.
