AN ACT ALLOWING ALL MILITARY SERVICE TO BE USED IN COMPUTING CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR RETIREMENT PURPOSES OF PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subdivision (1) of section 4 of chapter 32 of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by striking out paragraph (h),
3 as most recently amended by section 2 of chapter 671 of the
4 acts of 1966, and inserting in place thereof the following para-
5 graph:—

6 (h) The period or periods during which any member is a vet-
7 eran, as defined in section one, served in the armed forces of the
8 United States, regardless of the time thereof, shall be allowed
9 as creditable service; provided, however, that the last discharge
10 or release of said veteran was under honorable conditions as
11 defined in defense department regulations.

1 SECTION 2. Section fifty-eight A of said chapter thirty-two
2 is hereby repealed.
