AN ACT DIRECTING THE ART COMMISSION TO PROCURE A BUST OF CHRISTOPHER COLUMBUS TO BE INSTALLED IN THE STATE HOUSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The art commission established under section nineteen of
2 chapter six of the General Laws shall select and commission a
3 sculptor to create a bust of Christopher Columbus. The bust
4 shall, upon acceptance by the art commission, be installed in
5 a suitable location in the state house. The selection of the
6 sculptor shall be completed no later than June thirtieth,
7 nineteen hundred and sixty-nine. The commission may
8 expend for these purposes such sums as may be appropriated
9 by law.
