By Mr. Ambler of Weymouth, petition of Robert B. Ambler that provision be made for payment of motor vehicle excise taxes in installments. Taxation.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Eight.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE EXCISE TAX ON REGISTERED MOTOR VEHICLES MAY BE PAID IN INSTALLMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 60A of the General Laws, as most re-
2 cently amended by section 2 of chapter 231 of the acts of 1962,
3 is hereby further amended by striking out the seventh sentence
4 and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — The ex-
5 cise hereunder shall be due and payable at the expiration of
6 ninety days from the date upon which the notice was issued by
7 the collector or the commissioner pursuant to this section; pro-
8 vided, however, that said excise may be paid in equal weekly
9 installments during said period.
