AN ACT RELATIVE TO EQUALIZED VALUATION IN CERTAIN TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (f) defining "valuation percentage", of section 2
2 of chapter 70 of the General Laws, inserted by section 40 of
3 chapter 14 of the acts of 1966, is hereby amended by adding at
4 the end thereof the following sentence:— In towns with an
5 equalized valuation of less than ten million dollars, the "valua-
6 tion percentage" shall be the equalized valuation of the town
7 divided by the number of professional school persons, multi-
8 plied by twenty-six.
