AN ACT EXEMPTING FROM THE EXCISE ON RETAIL SALES CERTAIN PUBLICATIONS ISSUED AT REGULAR INTERVALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by striking out paragraph (*m*), as appearing in sec-
- 3 tion 1 of chapter 757 of the acts of 1967, and inserting in place
- 4 thereof the following paragraph:—
- 5 (*m*) Sales of newspapers, magazines, other publications is-
- 6 sued periodically at regular intervals and sold in part by sub-
- 7 scription, books required for instructional purposes in educa-
- 8 tional institutions, books used for religious worship, publica-
- 9 tions of any corporation, foundation, organization or institu-
- 10 tion described in paragraph (*e*) of this subsection, and motion
- 11 picture film for commercial exhibition.
