AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY TO CONVEY A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND IN QUINCY TO RICHARD M. MORRISSEY FOR RELOCATION PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (b) of sec-
2 tion five of chapter one hundred and sixty-one A of the General
3 Laws or any other provision of general or special law, the
4 Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority, hereinafter
5 called the authority, is authorized:— To sell and convey to
6 Richard M. Morrissey of Quincy, the principal officer of the
7 Cafe Viking of Quincy, a displaced occupant as a result of
8 eminent domain proceedings of the authority in that part of
9 Quincy known as Wollaston, a parcel of land in said Wollaston
10 for relocation purposes, at its fair market value, to which title
11 has been acquired by the said authority and which land or
12 rights therein the said authority determines not to be pres-
13 ently needed for its purposes.
