AN ACT PROVIDING FOR HALF FARES FOR SENIOR CITIZENS RIDING THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY LINES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Senior citizens shall be allowed to ride on any surface or
- 2 subway line of the Massachusetts Bay Transit Authority for
- 3 half of the regular fare schedule.
- 4 A senior citizen shall be any person who has reached his or
- 5 her sixty-fifth birthday.
- 6 Senior citizens shall be issued identification passes by the
- 7 Massachusetts Bay Transit Authority for purposes of ad-
- 8 ministering this act.
