AN ACT FORBIDDING CERTAIN OFFICIALS FROM DISCUSSING FEDERAL FUNDS IN EXECUTIVE SESSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 23C the following section:—
- 3 *Section 23D.* No elected or appointed official of any city,
- 4 town, county, or the commonwealth, or any subdivision
- 5 thereof, shall discuss the issue of federal financial aid in
- 6 executive session, except that this section shall not apply
- 7 to the welfare department, or any of its employees, of any
- 8 such governmental agency.
