AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN ADDITIONAL FEE IN THE ISSUANCE OF CERTAIN LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The licensing board of a city is hereby authorized to charge
2 the holder of a license for the sale of alcoholic beverages, to
3 be drunk on the premises, an additional fee for each room
4 containing a bar, when there is more than one bar being
5 operated in the establishment for which the original license
6 was issued.
