AN ACT AUTHORIZING TOWNS AT AN ANNUAL TOWN MEETING TO GRANT UNLIMITED TENURE OF OFFICE TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, a  
2 town may at an annual town meeting by a two-thirds vote  
3 grant unlimited tenure of office until age seventy to any  
4 employee or officer of the town except the moderator, select-  
5 men, registrars of voters, civil service employees and members  
6 of the school committee.
