

HOUSE No. 3047

By Mr. Kenney of Uxbridge, petition of F. Leo Kenney for legislation to establish a flat exemption of a certain sum of money due for real estate taxes by certain veterans. Taxation.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A FLAT EXEMPTION OF A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY DUE FOR TAXES BY CERTAIN VETERANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Clause Twenty-second of section 5 of chapter
2 59 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section
3 1 of chapter 359 of the acts of 1966, is hereby further
4 amended by inserting after the word "dollars", in line 13, the
5 words:—, or the sum of one hundred and seventy-five dollars
6 of actual taxes due, whichever is the greater.

1 SECTION 2. Clause Twenty-second A of said section 5 of
2 said chapter 59, as most recently amended by section 2 of
3 chapter 359 of the acts of 1966, is hereby further amended by
4 inserting in line 19, after the word "dollars" the following
5 words:—or the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars of
6 actual taxes due, whichever is the greater..

1 SECTION 3. Clause Twenty-second B of said section 5 of
2 said chapter 59, as most recently amended by section 3 of
3 chapter 359 of the acts of 1966, is hereby further amended by
4 inserting, in line 16, after the word "dollars", the following
5 words:—or the sum of seven hundred dollars of actual taxes
6 due, whichever is the greater.

1 SECTION 4. Clause Twenty-second C of said section 5 of
2 chapter 95, as most recently amended by section 4 of chapter
3 359 of the acts of 1966, is hereby further amended by insert-
4 ing, in line 14, after the word "dollars", the following words:—
5 or the sum of eight hundred and seventy-five dollars of actual
6 taxes due, whichever is the greater.
