**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Eight.

AN ACT EXEMPTING FROM THE INCOME TAX LAW THE INCOME FROM AN ANNUITY, PENSION, ENDOWMENT OR RETIREMENT FUND OF ANY OTHER STATE GOVERNMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 8 of chapter 62 of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by striking out paragraph (g), as most  
3 recently amended by section 1 of chapter 576 of the acts of  
4 1962, and inserting in place thereof the following para-  
5 graph:—

6 (g) All sums deducted from wages are contributions to an  
7 annuity, pension, endowment or retirement fund of the  
8 United States government, the commonwealth or any politi-  
9 cal subdivision thereof, or any private association formed in  
10 pursuance of sections thirty-nine and forty of chapter thirty-  
11 two, and any income from a contributory annuity, pension,  
12 endowment or retirement fund of the United States govern-  
13 ment or any other state, or any political subdivision thereof,  
14 or any income from a contributory annuity, pension, endow-  
15 ment or retirement fund as set forth in section forty-one of  
16 chapter thirty-two, to any of which the employee has con-  
17 tributed.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall apply to income received in  
2 taxable years commencing after December thirty-first, nine-  
3 teen hundred and sixty-eight.
