AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF QUINCY TO PAY AN ANNUITY TO GERTRUDE M. FITZGERALD, THE WIDOW OF DANIEL J. FITZGERALD, A FORMER POLICE OFFICER IN SAID CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of promoting the public good,
2 the city of Quincy is hereby authorized to pay to Gertrude M.
3 Fitzgerald, the widow of Daniel J. Fitzgerald late Quincy
4 police officer of said city, an annuity for life as long as she
5 remains unmarried the sum of two thousand dollars, the same
6 to be paid in equal monthly installments.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by
2 vote of the city council of the city of Quincy, with the
3 approval of its mayor, but not otherwise.
