AN ACT PROVIDING THAT PRIOR STATE SERVICE OF IDA LYONS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL BE COUNTED AS CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR VACATION LEAVE AND SICK LEAVE PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special
2 law to the contrary, Ida Lyons shall, for the purpose of comput-
3 ing her vacation leave and sick leave pursuant to rules and reg-
4 ulations relative thereto established by the director of personnel
5 and standardization under authority of section twenty-eight
6 of chapter seven of the General Laws, be credited with all prior
7 service performed by her as an employee of the department of
8 the attorney-general during the period December eighth, nine-
9 teen hundred and fifty-eight to January third, nineteen hun-
10 dred and sixty-three, inclusive.
