AN ACT REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE TO PAY THE TRANSPORTATION COSTS OF PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED PERSONS ON WELFARE WHILE TRAVELLING TO AND FROM MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 4 of chapter 118D, as most recently amended by  
2 chapter 658 of the acts of 1967, is hereby further amended by  
3 adding at the end thereof the following sentence:— The depart-  
4 ment shall reimburse the reasonable transportation costs of  
5 any physically handicapped person receiving aid from the de-  
6 partment while travelling to and from a medical appointment.
