AN ACT TO APPOINT SUPERVISORS OF SPECIAL CLASSES FOR MENTALLY RETARDED CHILDREN IN ALL CITIES AND TOWNS OF AT LEAST FIFTY THOUSAND INHABITANTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 46 of chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding the following paragraph: —

3 Every city and town in the commonwealth having a popu-
4 lation of at least fifty thousand inhabitants shall appoint a super-
5 visory of all special classes for mentally retarded children in that
6 city or town. Said supervisor to have had experience in teach-
7 ing in such special classes, or to be certified as qualified by the
8 department of special classes for mentally retarded children in
9 the department of education.
