AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING TRANSPORTATION CHARGES FOR DUMP TRUCK OPERATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 39B of chapter 30 of the General Laws as amended
- 2 is hereby further amended by adding the following para-
- 3 graph:—
- 4 Hourly rates prescribed or authorized by the department of
- 5 public utilities shall apply only when transportation charges
- 6 are being paid for directly by the commonwealth or any
- 7 political subdivision thereof, or when the origin and destina-
- 8 tion points are both within the same city or town, or within
- 9 ten air miles of each other. The determination of the air mile
- 10 limitation shall be computed on the official highway map of
- 11 Massachusetts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That
