AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF PERSONNEL AND STANDARDIZATION TO REALLOCATE CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE UNIFORMED BRANCH OF THE STATE POLICE IN THE GENERAL SALARY SCHEDULE AT THE REQUEST OF THE COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC SAFETY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provisions of law to the contrary,
2 the director of personnel and standardization shall, upon the
3 written request of the commissioner of public safety with the
4 approval of the governor, and upon certification by said com-
5 missioner that a member of the uniformed branch of the di-
6 vision of state police has rendered outstanding service, grant
7 a two-step rate increase in the general salary schedule, to
8 such member. No more than two such requests shall be made
9 or granted annually.
