## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Eight.

AN ACT PROVIDING AN EQUITY CLERK AND A CRIMINAL CLERK IN  
THE SUPERIOR COURT SITTING IN THE COUNTY OF BRISTOL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 Chapter 221 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting after section 6B the following section:—  
3 *Section 6C.* The clerk of the courts for the county of Bristol  
4 may designate one of the assistant clerks of court for said  
5 county to perform, under the direction of said clerk of the  
6 courts, the duties of clerk pertaining to the equity proceed-  
7 ings in said court, who shall receive from said county, in addi-  
8 tion to the salary paid to him as an assistant clerk, a sum  
9 equivalent to five per cent of the salary of the clerk. The clerk  
10 of the courts for said county may also designate another as-  
11 sistant clerk for said county to perform, under the direction  
12 of said clerk of the courts, the duties of clerk pertaining to  
13 criminal proceedings in said court, who shall receive from  
14 said county, in addition to the salary paid to him as an as-  
15 sistant clerk, a sum equivalent to five per cent of the salary  
16 of the clerk.
