RESOLUTIONS MEMORIALIZING THE CONGRESS TO AMEND THE FLAMMABLE FABRICS ACT WITH RESPECT TO CHILDREN'S CLOTHING.

1 *Whereas*, The Federal Flammable Fabrics Act, being Pub-
2 lic Law 88 of 1953, provides minimum standards with respect
3 to the flammability of all fabrics; and

4 *Whereas*, Fabrics incorporated in clothing, costumes or bed-
5 ding intended to be worn or used by children should be more
6 strictly regulated with respect to their flammability than fab-
7 rics generally; therefore be it

8 *Resolved*, That the Massachusetts House of Representatives
9 respectfully urges the congress of the United States to enact
10 legislation amending and strengthening the provisions of the
11 Flammable Fabrics Act as it would relate to the degree of flam-
12 mability permitted in fabrics and materials used in clothing,
13 costumes or bedding intended to be worn or used by children
14 under thirteen years of age; and be it further

15 *Resolved*, That copies of these resolutions be transmitted forth-
16 with by the secretary of the commonwealth to the President of
17 the United States, the presiding officer of each branch of con-
gress, and to the members thereof from this commonwealth.
