AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO CONSTRUCT A SUBSTATION IN THE CITY OF HAVERHILL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The department of public safety is hereby authorized and
- 2 directed to construct a state police substation in the city of
- 3 Haverhill on Route 495. For said purpose said department
- 4 may expend such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
